BANTAM HOUSE

This could have been avoided if the team selection was done in conjunction with all the coaches. In the end it was better but two teams were weaker. Bantam consisted of four teams. In the super league, the teams finished 3rd, 4th, 6th, and 9th in a nine-team league. Also we had trouble getting enough players out with each team having 12 to 14 players on each roster. I would recommend that carry as a minimum of 15 skaters and one goalie. This should go for midget also. This would allow for players that have other interests when missing the team still has enough players to play. It might also encourage players to go up to rep when called so they can get extra playing time. The year-end tournament was well run as 12 teams in total came.
