#### Notes:

1. Every registrant new to PMHA pays the early bird rate (June 1-30).
2. Every female new to hockey receives \$100 discount off the early bird rate.
3. Tryout fees are only for those trying out for representative teams (not for those only registering for recreation teams).
4. For U9 players wishing to be evaluated for the U9 Development team, there is no tryout fee.
5. For U13 players trying out for U13T1, they must register for that tryout separately through PMHA.
6. All (T2/T3/T4) tryout fees are paid through OMAHA. Players selected to teams hosted by PMHA teams are required to pay PMHA registration and rep fees.
7. Females wishing to dual roster on female and integrated teams (co-ed) are subject to a \$200 dual roster fee.
8. All players trying out for U15/U18 Female A teams and U15/U18AA Zone teams, must register and pay tryout and registration fees through OMAHA.
9. All players are also subject to their team fees established through the team's budgeting process. These fees cover apparel, tournament entries, team building, other extra curricular activities. These fees are traditionally \$200-\$600. These amounts may be refunded to the registrants at the end of the season, depending on the amount of fundraising completed by the teams.
10. Rep/Dev Fees cover carding fees, additional ice, increased referee costs, increased game costs.
11. Registrations must be made through TeamSnap by June 30 to receive early bird rate. See next note for when fees must be paid.
12. Registration fees must be paid in full by August 31. Rep fees must be paid in full by November 30. Failure to do so will result in the players being ineligible to play. Tryout fees must be paid prior to the player being allowed to tryout.

13. If financial assistance is needed, please refer to the PMHA website for options such as: Kidsport, Jumpstart, Hockey Canada, Athletics for Kids, or the PMHA Hardship Fund.

Registration can be completed through the PMHA website via TeamSnap starting on **June 1, 2025.**
